

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Health & Human Services.

HB25-1097 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike line 14 and substitute "CHILD."
- 2 Page 3, strike lines 18 through 27 and substitute "FROM ONE PLACEMENT
3 TO ANOTHER AND THAT COUNTY DEPARTMENTS WILL USE TO DEVELOP
4 INDIVIDUALIZED PLACEMENT TRANSITION PLANS. AN INDIVIDUALIZED
5 PLACEMENT TRANSITION PLAN MUST PRIORITIZE THE MENTAL, EMOTIONAL,
6 AND PHYSICAL NEEDS OF THE CHILD WHILE CONSIDERING THE NEEDS OF".
- 7 Page 4, line 1, strike "PROVIDERS." and substitute "PROVIDERS, AS THE
8 NEEDS OF THE PARENTS, CURRENT PROVIDERS, AND FUTURE PROVIDERS
9 RELATE TO THE CARE OF THE CHILD."
- 10 Page 4, line 2, strike "A" and substitute "ABSENT AN EMERGENCY
11 PLACEMENT CHANGE, A" and after "DEPARTMENT" insert "CHILD
12 WELFARE".
- 13 Page 4, line 3, strike "INDIVIDUAL" and substitute "INDIVIDUALIZED".
- 14 Page 4, line 6, after "HOME." add "THE COUNTY DEPARTMENT CHILD
15 WELFARE CASEWORKER SHALL DOCUMENT THE INDIVIDUALIZED
16 PLACEMENT TRANSITION PLAN IN THE STATE AUTOMATED CASE
17 MANAGEMENT SYSTEM."
- 18 Page 4, after line 6 insert:
19 "(II) THE INDIVIDUALIZED PLACEMENT TRANSITION PLAN MUST BE
20 DEVELOPED IN A MEETING WITH ALL PARTIES TO THE CASE, THE CURRENT
21 AND PROSPECTIVE PROVIDERS, AND THE CHILD IF IT IS APPROPRIATE TO THE
22 CHILD'S AGE OR DEVELOPMENTAL LEVEL. IF A PARTY OR PROVIDER DOES
23 NOT AGREE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MEETING, THE PARTY OR PROVIDER
24 WAIVES THEIR RIGHT TO WEIGH IN ON THE PLACEMENT TRANSITION PLAN.
25 IF ALL PARTIES AND PROVIDERS AGREE THAT A MEETING IS NOT REQUIRED,
26 THE MEETING MAY BE WAIVED.
27 (III) IF A SIBLING GROUP IS MOVED FROM A PLACEMENT TOGETHER,
28 THE COUNTY DEPARTMENT CHILD WELFARE CASEWORKER MAY DEVELOP
29 ONE INDIVIDUALIZED PLACEMENT TRANSITION PLAN FOR THE SIBLING
30 GROUP AS LONG AS THE PLAN TAKES INTO ACCOUNT THE INDIVIDUALIZED
31 NEEDS OF EACH CHILD."
- 32 Renumber succeeding subparagraph accordingly.

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
