

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 25, strike lines 4 through 16 and substitute:

2 "(3) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$3,500,000 is appropriated
3 to the department of public safety. This appropriation is from the
4 behavioral and mental health cash fund created in section 24-75-230
5 (2)(a), C.R.S., and is of money that the state received from the federal
6 coronavirus state fiscal recovery fund. To implement this act, the
7 department may use this appropriation as follows:

8 (a) \$191,563 for use by the division of criminal justice for DCJ
9 administrative services, which amount is based on an assumption that the
10 division will require an additional 2.5 FTE in the 2022-23 state fiscal
11 year;

12 (b) \$1,547,728 for use by the division of criminal justice for
13 behavioral health information grants; and

14 (c) \$1,760,709 for the purchase of information technology
15 services.

16 (4) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$1,760,709 is appropriated
17 to the office of the governor for use by the office of information
18 technology. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received
19 from the department of public safety under subsection (1)(c) of this
20 section. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to
21 provide information technology services for the department of public
22 safety."
