6 (d) THE BUREAU SHALL BE OPEN FROM 9 A.M. TO 9 P.M. EVERY
7 CALENDAR DAY, EXCEPT EASTER DAY, CHRISTMAS DAY, AND
8 THANKSGIVING DAY, IN ORDER TO TRANSMIT IN A TIMELY MANNER A
9 REQUEST FOR A BACKGROUND CHECK TO THE NICS SYSTEM AND OTHER
10 DATABASES.

11 (e) SUBSECTION (7)(b)(IV)(A) OF THIS SECTION WILL BE REPEALED
12 AND SUBSECTION (7)(d) OF THIS SECTION WILL TAKE EFFECT IF A COURT OF
13 COMPETENT JURISDICTION HOLDS THAT SECTION 18-12-115 IS
14 UNCONSTITUTIONAL AND, IF APPLICABLE, THE TIME TO APPEAL THE
15 DECISION HAS EXPIRED. THE SOLICITOR GENERAL SHALL NOTIFY THE
16 REVISOR OF STATUTES IN WRITING OF THE DATE WHEN THE CONDITION
17 SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBSECTION (7)(e) HAS OCCURRED BY EMAILING THE
18 NOTICE TO REVISOROFSTATUTES.GA@COLEG.GOV. SUBSECTION
19 (7)(b)(IV)(A) OF THIS SECTION IS REPEALED AND SUBSECTION (7)(d) OF
20 THIS SECTION TAKES EFFECT UPON THE DATE IDENTIFIED IN THE NOTICE
21 THAT A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION HELD THAT SECTION
22 18-12-115 IS UNCONSTITUTIONAL AND, IF APPLICABLE, THE TIME TO
23 APPEAL THE DECISION HAS EXPIRED OR, IF THE NOTICE DOES NOT SPECIFY
24 THAT DATE, UPON THE DATE OF THE NOTICE TO THE REVISOR OF
25 STATUTES.".
