

AMENDMENT TO REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Representative Flanell moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in not adopting the following Flanell amendment, (L.006) to HB26-1144, to show that said amendment passed and that HB26-1144, as amended, passed.

Amend printed bill, page 2, line 7, after "**penalties -**" insert "**notice to the revisor of statutes -**".

Page 4, after line 25, add:

"(5) (a) THE COLORADO BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION SHALL STUDY WHETHER THREE-DIMENSIONALLY PRINTED FIREARMS ARE STATISTICALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR A MEASURABLE PERCENTAGE OF GUN CRIMES IN COLORADO. THE BUREAU SHALL COMPLETE THE STUDY ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2026. AT THE COMPLETION OF THE STUDY, THE BUREAU SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER THREE-DIMENSIONALLY PRINTED FIREARMS ARE STATISTICALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR A MEASURABLE PERCENTAGE OF GUN CRIMES IN COLORADO. THE BUREAU SHALL PUBLISH THE COMPLETED STUDY AND DETERMINATION ON ITS WEBSITE AND SUBMIT IT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

(b) SUBSECTIONS (1) TO (4) OF THIS SECTION WILL TAKE EFFECT IF THE BUREAU DETERMINES, PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (5)(a) OF THIS SECTION, THAT THREE-DIMENSIONALLY PRINTED FIREARMS ARE STATISTICALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR A MEASURABLE PERCENTAGE OF GUN CRIMES IN COLORADO. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY SHALL NOTIFY THE REVISOR OF STATUTES IN WRITING OF THE DATE WHEN THE CONDITION SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBSECTION (5)(b) HAS OCCURRED BY EMAILING THE NOTICE TO REVISOROFSTATUTES.GA@COLEG.GOV. SUBSECTIONS (1) TO (4) OF THIS SECTION TAKE EFFECT UPON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE DATE IDENTIFIED IN THE NOTICE THAT THE BUREAU MADE THE DETERMINATION OCCURRED OR, IF THE NOTICE DOES NOT SPECIFY THAT DATE, UPON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE DATE OF THE NOTICE TO THE REVISOR OF STATUTES."
