Second Reading

1 Amend the Judiciary Committee Report, dated March 11, 2026, page 1,
2 strike lines 1 through 20 and substitute:

3 "Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 2 through 11.

4 Strike pages 3 and 4."

5 Page 2 of the report, strike lines 1 through 16.

6 Page 2 of the report, strike lines 32 and 33.

7 Page 3 of the report, strike lines 1 through 10 and substitute:

8 "(2) A DETENTION FACILITY MUST HAVE AN ELECTRONIC TRACKING
9 SYSTEM THAT RETAINS A LOG OF ALL ACCESS TO VIDEO FOOTAGE,
10 INCLUDING BODY-WORN CAMERA FOOTAGE, CAPTURED BY THE LOCAL
11 DETENTION FACILITY.

12 (3) WHILE NOT ON THE PREMISE OF A LOCAL DETENTION FACILITY,
13 PERSONNEL OF A LOCAL DETENTION FACILITY SHALL NOT ACCESS VIDEO
14 FOOTAGE, INCLUDING BODY-WORN CAMERA FOOTAGE, CAPTURED BY A
15 LOCAL DETENTION FACILITY.

16 (4) PERSONNEL OF A LOCAL DETENTION FACILITY MUST OBTAIN
17 WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE SHERIFF AND DOCUMENT WHAT VIDEO
18 FOOTAGE THEY ARE ACCESSING AND THE REASON THEY ARE ACCESSING IT
19 BEFORE ACCESSING ANY FOOTAGE, INCLUDING BODY-WORN CAMERA
20 FOOTAGE, CAPTURED IN A LOCAL DETENTION FACILITY. WHEN A SHERIFF
21 IS ACCESSING FOOTAGE CAPTURED IN A LOCAL DETENTION FACILITY, THEY
22 MUST DOCUMENT WHAT FOOTAGE THEY ARE ACCESSING AND THE REASON
23 THEY ARE ACCESSING IT.

24 (5) IF A LOCAL DETENTION FACILITY STORES VIDEO FOOTAGE OF
25 STRIP SEARCHES SEPARATELY FROM THE FOOTAGE OF THE REST OF THE
26 LOCAL DETENTION FACILITY, AND ACCESS TO THE STRIP SEARCH FOOTAGE
27 IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS
28 SECTION, THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (4) OF THIS SECTION ONLY
29 APPLY TO THE SEPARATE STRIP SEARCH FOOTAGE."

30 Page 3 of the report, line 11, strike "(4)" and substitute "(6)".
