Summary of Legislation

The bill adds Senator Faith Winter’s name to the Representative Hugh McKean Colorado Youth Advisory Council Review Committee in the Legislative Department.

The review committee’s name henceforth is “The Representative Hugh McKean and Senator Faith Winter Colorado Youth Advisory Council Review Committee.”

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill renames an advisory committee of the General Assembly. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
