**Bill Topic:** CHANGE FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION TO FDA

---

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** This bill replaces references to the federal food and drug administration in the Colorado Health Care Coverage Act with the term “FDA”. The bill has no impact on state or local government revenue or expenditures, so is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

## Summary of Legislation

The bill replaces references to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration with the term “FDA” in the Colorado Health Care Coverage Act.

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill simplifies statutory language and does not affect the revenue or expenditures for any agency of state or local government; therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 25, 2022, and takes effect August 9, 2022, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
