Further, it should not, and never should have been the right of the clerk and recorder, the DMV, to designate a persons' political party preference! The number of people who have not even been aware of how their party designation was recorded is really amazing.</p> <p>In keeping with the idea: "TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOURSELF, AND YOUR VOTING RECORD, AFFILIATION" is really important!</p> <p>If people are given a notice, and do not respond, there are stop-gap methods to further notify a person. However, if they are inactive for a specific amount of time, as noted in this bill, it is reasonable for the voter roll to note some form of status. <p>Ingrid Moore Against themselves</p>	<p>I strongly OPPOSE this bill.</p> <p>This bill creates unnecessary barriers to voter registration by adding additional steps and requirements that could discourage participation, particularly among new or less engaged voters by requiring affirmative voter input for party affiliation.</p> <p>The automatic marking of registrations as inactive for voters who skip two general elections could disenfranchise eligible voters who may wish to participate in future elections but face additional hurdles to reactivate their registration.</p>
