HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.HB17-1326 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 17, after line 20 insert:

2 **"SECTION 8. Appropriation - adjustments to 2017 long bill.**

3 (1) To implement this act, appropriations made in the annual general
4 appropriation act for the 2017-18 state fiscal year to the department of
5 corrections are adjusted as follows:

6 (a) The general fund appropriation for payments to local jails is
7 increased by \$186,128;

8 (b) The general fund appropriation for payments to in-state private
9 prisons is decreased by \$2,485,477;

10 (c) The general fund appropriation for payments to prerelease
11 parole revocation facilities is decreased by \$1,242,738; and

12 (d) The general fund appropriation for payments to community
13 return to custody facilities is decreased by \$3,241,110.

14 (2) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$103,824 is appropriated to
15 the department of corrections for use by the information systems
16 subprogram. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement
17 this act, the department may use this appropriation for the purchase of
18 information technology services.

19 (3) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$50,972 is appropriated to
20 the department of corrections for use by the parole subprogram. This
21 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the
22 department may use this appropriation as follows:

23 (a) \$45,319 for personal services, which amount is based on an
24 assumption that the department will require an additional 1.0 FTE; and

25 (b) \$5,653 for operating expenses.

26 (4) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$6,628,401 is appropriated
27 to the department of local affairs. This appropriation is from the general
28 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation
29 as follows:

30 (a) \$56,040 for use by the division of local government for field
31 services program costs, which amount is based on an assumption that the
32 division will require an additional 0.9 FTE;

33 (b) \$6,519,320 for use by the division of local government for
34 small business lending and grant funding.

35 (c) \$4,753 for the purchase of legal services; and

36 (d) \$48,288 for the purchase of information technology services.

37 (5) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$4,753 is appropriated to the



1 department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
2 received from the department of local affairs under subsection (4)(c) of
3 this section. To implement this act, the department of law may use this
4 appropriation to provide legal services for the department of local affairs.

5 (6) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$103,824 is appropriated to
6 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
7 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
8 department of corrections under subsection (2) of this section. To
9 implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide
10 information technology services for the department of corrections.

11 (7) For the 2017-18 state fiscal year, \$48,288 is appropriated to
12 the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology.
13 This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from the
14 department of local affairs under subsection (4)(d) of this section. To
15 implement this act, the office may use this appropriation to provide
16 information technology services for the department of local affairs."

17 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
